

# ELIGIBILITY & SELECTION CRITERIA

Admission Regulations for the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com (Honours/General) Courses of Studies under 1+1+1 system of Examination.

## *The essential criteria*

- A candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination is eligible to seek admission in the first year of 3 year B.A/B.Sc/B.Com (Hons/Gen) Courses of studies provided he/she has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100.
- No candidate will be allowed for admission after a lapse of more than five years of passing of or equivalent examination. The students having year of passing the qualifying examination before 2013 is not eligible to seek the admission.
- If the candidates have passed vocational examination (10+2) course he/she will be eligible to seek admission to the B.A. General first year course of studies taking the subjects under Humanities Division only.

*For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the Honours Course, aggregate marks obtained at pre-qualifying examination shall be calculated by **adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks** secured by a candidate.*

*However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education and Environmental Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.*

## *The Course wise criteria*

*For the admission in General Courses*

- Admission in General Courses (B.A/B.Sc/B.Com): The candidate should have 30% marks in aggregate.

*For the admission in Honours Courses (basic criteria)*

- (i) Minimum 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the respective subject (or related subject) at previous qualifying examination.
- Or
- (ii) The 55% marks in the respective subject (or related subject) and 45% marks in the aggregate at previous qualifying examination.

*However, candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe Community (SC/ST) taking up Honours Course of study must have obtained a minimum 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.*

- The students have to choose compulsory subjects as Bengali and English.

*Courses offered in different streams and specific criteria*

**B.Sc. Courses:**

(3 Years -6 Semester courses of study under CBCS Scheme by the order *C.U. Notification No. CSR/268/18, dt. 07.05.2018*)

**CEMA:**

- For Chemistry Honours, students should have Chemistry as the related subject and have qualifying marks in both theory and practical in the pre qualifying Examination.
- Students have to accept Physics (PHSG) and Mathematics (MTMG) as Generic Elective subjects along with his/her Honours Core Courses. Two Generic Electives Courses from Physics and two Generic Elective Courses from Mathematics are required to be chosen in the first four semesters.

**MTMA:**

- For Mathematics Honours, students should have to pass Mathematics with requisite marks in the pre qualifying examination. However, the students have Business Mathematics in the pre qualifying Examination can also apply for this Mathematics Honours course.
- Students have to accept Physics (PHSG) and Chemistry (CEMG) as Generic Elective subjects along with his/her Honours Core Courses. Two Generic Electives Courses from Physics and two Generic Elective Courses from Chemistry are required to be chosen in the first four semesters.

## PHSA:

- For Physics Honours, student should have Physics & Mathematics in the pre qualifying Examination. He/She must have at least 50% in Mathematics to apply in this course along with the requisite marks in the Physics.
- Students have to accept Chemistry (CEMG) and Mathematics (MTMG) as Generic Elective subjects along with his/her Honours Core Courses. Two Generic Electives Courses from Mathematics and two Generic Elective Courses from Chemistry are required to be chosen in the first four semesters.

## ECO A:

- The students who have passed Mathematics/ Business Mathematics other than Economics in pre qualifying examination are also eligible to apply for this course. However, student requires at least 50% marks in Mathematics/Business Mathematics and he/she must clear theory part, if any.
- Students who have passed only Economics but did not qualify in Mathematics in prequalifying examination will not be allowed for this course.
- The eligibility criteria for SC/ST candidate is 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in related subject is as usual but he/she requires to secure 50% marks in Mathematics or Business Mathematics.
- Students have to accept Mathematics (MTMG) and Political Science (PLSG) Generic Elective subjects along with his/her Honours Core Courses. Two Generic Electives Courses from Mathematics and two Generic Elective Courses from Political Science are required to be chosen in the first four semesters.

## B.Sc. (General)

- In B.Sc. (General) the subject combination is Physics (PHSG), Chemistry (CEMG) and Mathematics (MTMG). Students have to take three Core Courses in each subjects in the following four semesters.

## **B.Com Courses**

(3 Years -6 Semester courses of study under CBCS Scheme by the order *C.U. Notification No. CSR/26/17, dt. 26.05.2017*)

### **B.Com (Honours)**

- For the Students from the Commerce Background [Who have commerce in the prequalifying examination] the related subjects are as follows:

- A candidate from Science background can also apply for this course. In that case candidate must have 50% in aggregate and 50% in Mathematics.
- The eligibility criteria for SC/ST candidate are 40% marks in aggregate or a 40% mark in the related subject is as usual.

### **B.Com General:**

- A candidate shall be allowed to take up B.Com. (General) Course if he/she had passed the subject(s) at the previous qualifying examination as mentioned below:

- The requisite criterion for aggregate is applicable here for admission.

- Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational Examination in Business & Commerce conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.Com. (General) 1<sup>st</sup> year Course of Studies under this University

### B.A.Courses:

(3 Years -6 Semester courses of study under CBCS Scheme by the order *C.U. Notification No. CSR/268/18, dt. 07.05.2018*)

### BNGA: (Honours in Bengali)

- The marks wise criteria should be satisfied in the subject Bengali only. The students **who did not have Bengali** in prequalifying examination **are not eligible** for this course.
- Two Generic Electives Courses from Subject 1 and two Generic Elective Courses from Subject 2 are required to be chosen in the first four semesters. The possible subject combinations available are given below:

### ENGA: (Honours in English)

- The marks wise criteria should be satisfied in the subject English only. The students who did not have English in prequalifying examination are not eligible for this course.
- Two Generic Electives Courses from Subject 1 and two Generic Elective Courses from Subject 2 are required to be chosen in the first four semesters. The possible subject combinations available are given below:

### PLSA: (Honours in Political Science)

- The marks wise criteria should be satisfied in the subject Political Science only. The students who did not have the Political Science in prequalifying examination are not eligible for this course.
- Two Generic Electives Courses from Subject 1 and two Generic Elective Courses from Subject 2 are required to be chosen in the first four semesters. The possible subject combinations available are given below:

### PHIA: (Honours in Philosophy)

- The marks wise criteria should be satisfied in the subject Psychology other than Philosophy. Here, Psychology is treated as the relevant subject for this course.
- Two Generic Electives Courses from Subject 1 and two Generic Elective Courses from Subject 2 are required to be chosen in the first four semesters. The possible subject combinations available are given below:

- Two Generic Electives Courses from Subject 1 and two Generic Elective Courses from Subject 2 are required to be chosen in the first four semesters. The possible subject combinations available are given below:

- The marks wise criteria should be satisfied in the subject Education or any of the following related subjects:

- Students from other streams (Science/Commerce) can apply for this course if he/she passed with Mathematics with the requisite criteria.
- Two Generic Electives Courses from Subject 1 and two Generic Elective Courses from Subject 2 are required to be chosen in the first four semesters. The possible subject combinations available are given below:

## B.A. General

- The requisite criterion for aggregate is applicable here for admission.
- Here students have to choose altogether three subjects. Among the three subjects two subjects will be the Core subjects and third subjects will be the treated as Genetic Elective.
- The Core subjects will be continued for two years and 4 Core Courses from subject 1 and subject 2 are required to be taken. Only two Generic Electives in the first two semesters are required to be taken from the third subject.



- The available subjects in our College are:

- However, some subjects are mutually exclusive. Student can choose either of them. Such subjects are English/Sanskrit, History/Philosophy, Bengali/Economics, and Political Science/Education.
- There is no restriction about the choice of the third subject. Any one from the subject combinations given below can be chosen as third subject, which will be read only in two semesters.
